

Entry/Renewal Requirements for

SFA and CFA Providers, Instructors and Instructor-Trainers

Providers/Instructors/Chief Instructors/Instructor-Trainers/Chief Instructor-Trainers of the respective courses must bear full responsibility for the attainment and renewal of their status.

Entry	Physically healthy and able to complete course objectives.
Validity	2 years from date of completion of Provider course.
Renewal	Attends a re-certification course 3 months before or after expiry of certificate.
